We are pleased with how downtown Oroville is looking this summer with the new trees, the beautiful flower pots & hanging baskets and the new mural.

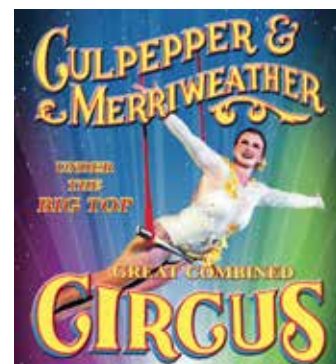
