Pickleball Courts Are "Almost" Open!! - We were hoping to have the courts open by July 1st but the weather didn't cooperate for painting the courts and lines. We are, however, "pleased as pickles" to announce that the new pickleball courts at Veteran's Memorial Park will be open in early July! First Annual Lake Osoyoos Family Festival - The Highlands Community Support Coalition has been working closely with the Oroville Chamber of Commerce, the Oroville Initiative and the Jet Ski Race coordinators to introduce a new event that will run in conjunction with the jet ski races on August 3rd: The Lake Osoyoos Family Festival. The Festival will be located at Deep Bay Park and features Apple Bin Racing (on the lake!) and Cornhole and Horseshoe tournaments. Apple bin race winner is \$300, \$100 to 2nd and Cornhole & Horseshoe 1st place is \$200, \$100 to 2nd. New Horseshoe Pits At Deep Bay - The Oroville Initiative has been working with the Highlands Community Support Coalition and the City of Oroville to install four regulation Horseshoe pits for tournaments at Deep Bay Park. Members from each group met last month at Deep Bay to determine the best location for the pits. The plan is to have the pits completed by the Lake Osoyoos Cup Jet Ski Races on August 3-4 for the new family festival that will run in conjunction with the jet ski races.



Riding The Roads Of Oroville - Bicycle Rides Northwest is bringing 300 cyclists to Oroville for two nights July 16 & 17. The group starts a seven day ride in Colville and travels through Curlew, Oroville, Republic and back to Colville. Senior events include cow riding, calf roping, regular saddle bronc, ranch saddle bronc, bareback, wild cow milking, open barrel races, and women's breakaway roping. Admission is \$5 and 6 and under are free. A community dance featuring Boones Toones is planned for July 3rd from 8-12. Admission for the dance is \$5 and 6 and under free.
